




Mobility Planning Process





Mobility Planning Process






One-Way Couplet

Out of 28 responses

- 32% (9) strongly support
- 21% (6) somewhat support
- 7% (2) support neutral
- 32% (9) do not support
- 7% (2) strongly do not support






Transit/ Multimodal/ Emergency Access

Out of 32 responses

- 41% (13) strongly support
- 6% (2) somewhat support
- 6% (2) support neutral
- 22% (7) do not support
- 25% (8) strongly do not support





What are your modal priorities for right-of-way on University?

Out of 32 responses (each chose two)

- 1. 53% (17) Bicycle facilities
- 2. 47% (15) Transit facilities
- 3. 44% (14) Active public spaces
- 4. 41% (13) Wider sidewalks
- 5. 9% (3) On-street parking
- 6. 6% (2) Vehicular facilities



Also discussed...

- Intersection crossings (pedestrian lead interval, noturn on red, pedestrian scramble, curb extension, protected intersection, etc.)
- Mid-block crossings (RRFB, HAWK, etc.)
- Park-once concept
- Mobility hubs
- Alleyway activation

Network Development

- Input from community members
- Interagency meetings
 - Caltrans shared concerns about traffic backing up onto SR-163
 - SANDAG is flexible on the LRT alignment; shared a concept on Robinson over the bridge; traffic calming on University and Robinson; buffered bike lanes on Robinson
 - Fire Department shared concerns about emergency response and access to buildings with wider sidewalks and public spaces


Option 1: Transit/Multimodal/Emergency Access Only


Option 2: Transit Only Lanes & One Vehicle Travel Lane in Each Direction






Draft Bicycle Network

Contra-Flow Bike Lane

- Provides connectivity and access to cyclists traveling in both directions
- Eliminates out-of-direction travel for cyclists
- Reduces wrong-way riding
- Decreases sidewalk riding

Advisory Bike Lane

(Edge Lane Road)

- Constraint roadway width
- Low speed
- Low volume




EXISTING CURB-TO-CURB VARIES BETWEEN 56' AND 68'
